Large-Type Edition Only Regents Examination in Physical Setting/Physics

Questions 51 and 52, only

Because the scaled vector diagram for Questions 51 and 52 is enlarged for the Large-Type edition, the acceptable responses for these questions differ from those listed in the Scoring Key and Rating Guide. For all students who used the Large-Type edition, allow credit for all responses to Questions 51 and 52 shown as acceptable in either (a) the original Scoring Key and Rating Guide or (b) shown as acceptable in the revised rubrics below.

51 [1] Allow 1 credit for $1.0 \text{ cm} = 7.4 \text{ N} \pm 1 \text{ N}$. 1.0 cm

52 [1] Allow 1 credit for drawing the resultant vector $13.5 \text{ cm} \pm 0.2 \text{ cm}$ long at an angle of $37^\circ \pm 2^\circ$ east of north.

Note: Do *not* deduct credit if the vector is not labeled.
